You should attach any supporting documents with your completed annulment application.

Your annulment application must be received before the due date on the enforcement order or a \$50 application fee will apply.

What happens after I send my application to the State Debt Recovery Office (SDRO)?

If the fine is withdrawn, you will not have to pay the fine.

If the fine is not withdrawn, you can:

- pay the enforcement order in full

OR

- have the fine listed before a local court nearest to where the offence is alleged to have occurred. You will be advised of the date and time to appear at the local court.
